Dr Cançado received his medical degree from Santa Casa Medical School, in São Paulo, Brazil. Subsequently, he completed his internship and residency in Hematology and Hemotherapy at the same Institution.

Dr Cançado was awarded his MD (2000) and his PhD in Hematology (2004) from Santa Casa Medical School. His main research interests are in the areas of anemias, haemoglobinopathies as well as disorders of the iron metabolism. He has been the Coordinator of the Anemias Program under the Department of Hematology and Oncology at Santa Casa Medical School since 1995.
